## Format and Regulations – August 14<sup>th</sup> 2022



- Two Divisions
  - Division 1 – Year 7 and Year 8 teams (Can be one or the other or mixture of both)
  - Division 2 – Year 9
- Games will be 2 x 10min halves with 2 min half time. First round will start at 9.00am
- Games will be played according to INF rules.
- All teams will play up to 6 games
- Umpire and Managers meeting at 8.15am in pavilion
- Teams to supply own umpire, failure to do so will result in registration being cancelled. No coaches or managers to umpire own teams games.
- Umpires will umpire own teams games (until finals). Score cards to be collected from the registration window before each round commences. To be returned immediately after game ends.
- All games will start and stop on the central bell. No game extensions will be allowed.
- A representative from each team shall share scoring responsibilities. The scorecard is the official score.
- In the event of injury or illness, the player must immediately be removed from the court for play to continue.
- Points will be awarded:
  - Win: 4 points
  - Draw: 2 points
  - Loss by 3 or less: 1 point
  - Loss by more than 3: 0 points
- Tied points at the end of pool play will be split by highest goal ratio (For/Against)
- To determine final placings, cross-over will occur between pools. (1 v 1, 2 v 2 etc).
